Geneva, 4 September 2024: Wizz Air Holdings Plc ("Wizz Air"), the most environmentally sustainable European airline, announces that Barry Eccleston, Senior Independent Non-Executive Director, and Chair of the Remuneration Committee, has informed the Board that, due to personal reasons, he has elected to take a temporary leave of absence.

During Barry's leave of absence, with immediate effect, Stephen Johnson, Deputy Chair, and current observer of the Remuneration Committee, will assume the role of Interim Chair of the Remuneration Committee.
