GCP Infra today announces that pursuant to the general authority granted by shareholders of the Company at the annual general meeting on 14 February 2024 to make market purchases of its own ordinary shares, it repurchased 100,000 ordinary shares at a weighted average price of 70.00 pence per share, to be held in treasury, on 7 January 2025.

Following this transaction, the Company has in issue 884,797,669 ordinary shares of which 19,215,019 are held in treasury.

For reporting purposes under the FCA's Disclosure Guidance and Transparency Rules the market should exclude any shares held in treasury and should use the figure of 865,582,650 voting rights when determining if they are required to notify their interest in, or a change to their interest in the Company.
