

#### Transaction in Own Shares

**Calgary, AB and Houston, TX - March 11, 2025-** PetroTal Corp. ("**PetroTal**" or the "**Company**") (TSX: TAL, AIM: PTAL and OTCQX: PTALF,) announces that, in accordance with the terms of its share buyback programme announced on 23 May 2024, it has purchased the following number of common shares of no par value each in the capital of the Company ("**Common Shares**") through Stifel Nicolaus Europe Limited ("**Stifel**"). The repurchased shares will be cancelled.
