Issue of Equity - Dividend Investment Scheme

The Board of Maven Income and Growth VCT PLC (the Company) confirms that, on 18 July 2025 and under its Dividend Investment Scheme (DIS), the Company issued and allotted 516,013 new Ordinary Shares of 10p each at a price of 37.97p per share which, under the Terms and Conditions of the DIS, is equivalent to the latest announced net asset value per share.

As a result, and in accordance with the Financial Conduct Authority's Disclosure Guidance and Transparency Rules, the Company confirms that its issued share capital as at 18 July 2025 comprises 181,957,056 Ordinary Shares of 10p each, with each share carrying one voting right. The above figure may be used by Shareholders as the denominator for the calculations by which they will determine if they are required, under the Disclosure Guidance and Transparency Rules, to notify their interest, or a change to their interest, in the Company.

Application has been made to the Financial Conduct Authority and the London Stock Exchange for the new Ordinary Shares issued under the DIS to be admitted to the Official List and to trading on the London Stock Exchange's main market for listed securities. It is expected that admission will become effective and dealings will commence on, or around, 23 July 2025.
