Whitbread PLC ("Whitbread") announces today that it has purchased the following number of its ordinary shares of 76 122/153 pence each through Morgan Stanley & Co. International Plc ('Morgan Stanley'). Such purchase was effected pursuant to instructions issued by Whitbread pursuant to the share buy-back programme as announced on 1 May 2025:

Whitbread intends to cancel the purchased shares.

Since 1 May 2025, Whitbread has purchased 3,634,642 shares at a cost excluding dealing and associated costs of £108,145,406.08.

Following settlement of the above transaction, Whitbread will hold 12,454,718 of its ordinary shares in treasury and has 185,391,376 ordinary shares in issue (including treasury shares).

Therefore, the total number of voting rights in Whitbread will be 172,936,658 and this figure may be used by shareholders as the denominator when determining whether they are required to notify their interest in, or a change to their interest in, Whitbread under the Financial Conduct Authority's Disclosure Guidance and Transparency Rules.

Whitbread notes that in its announcements in respect of transactions in own shares made between 8 October 2025 and 13 October 2025, the ordinary shares in issue (including treasury shares) and the total number of voting rights in Whitbread were erroneously stated. On 8 October 2025, the ordinary shares in issue (including treasury shares) should have been 185,617,413 and the total number of voting rights should have been 173,162,695. On 9 October 2025, the ordinary shares in issue (including treasury shares) should have been 185,575,868 and the total number of voting rights should have been 173,121,150. On 10 October 2025, the ordinary shares in issue (including treasury shares) should have been 185,473,682 and the total number of voting rights should have been 173,018,964. On 13 October 2025, the ordinary shares in issue (including treasury shares) should have been 185,469,820 and the total number of voting rights should have been 173,015,102.
