On January 5, 2023, DCP Midstream and the General Partner, which together own 56.5% of the issued and outstanding units of DCP Common Units, delivered a written consent approving the merger agreement with a wholly owned subsidiary of Phillips 66 Project Development Inc., an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Phillips 66. The merger was consummated before the open on June 15, 2023. As a result, each existing DCP Common Unit will be converted into the right to receive \$41.75 net cash per share.

**Contract Adjustment**

**New Deliverable  
Per Contract:** \$4,175.00 Cash (\$41.75 x 100)

Settlement in DCP options will take place through OCC's cash settlement system. Settlement will be accomplished by payment of the difference between the extended strike amount and the cash deliverable.

**Acceleration of Expirations**

Pursuant to OCC Rule 807, equity stock option contracts whose deliverables are adjusted to call for cash-only delivery will be subject to an acceleration of the expiration dates for outstanding option series. (See OCC Information Memo 23707) Additionally, the exercise by exception (ex by ex) threshold for expiring series will be \$.01 in all account types.

All series of DCP Midstream, LP options whose expiration dates are after 07-21-2023 will have their expiration dates advanced to 07-21-2023. Expiration dates occurring before 07-21-2023 (e.g., Flex options) will remain unchanged.

All DCP Midstream, LP options will utilize a \$.01 exercise threshold.

Existing Expiration: All months  
New expiration date: 07-21-2023

Existing American-style DCP Midstream, LP options remain exercisable at the option of the holder prior to their expiration. Exercised options will continue to settle in two business days.
