On January 5, 2023, DCP Midstream, LP (DCP) and its general partner, DCP Midstream GP, LLC, which together own 56.5% of the issued and outstanding units of DCP Common Units, delivered a written consent approving the merger agreement with a wholly owned subsidiary of Phillips 66 Project Development Inc., a subsidiary of Phillips 66. If and when the merger is consummated, each existing DCP Common Unit will be converted into the right to receive \$41.75 net cash per share.

Exercise Consideration – DCP options will not be adjusted to include any regular distributions. Call option holders who wish to receive any ordinary distributions paid prior to consummation of the merger should exercise their options in sufficient time to become shareholders of record. In all cases, it is the sole responsibility of persons holding call options seeking to receive the underlying securities to determine when to exercise their options.

Contract Adjustment

Date: Effective the opening of the business day after the merger is consummated.
Contract adjustment is expected to occur in the second quarter of 2023.

New Deliverable
Per Contract: \$4,175.00 Cash (\$41.75 x 100)

Settlement in DCP options will take place through OCC's cash settlement system. Settlement will be accomplished by payment of the difference between the extended strike amount and the cash deliverable.

Acceleration of Expirations

Pursuant to OCC Rule 807, equity stock option contracts whose deliverables are adjusted to call for cash-only delivery will be subject to **an acceleration of the expiration dates for outstanding option series** (See OCC Information Memo 23988).
